2. Guide	lines	This program will be available on a tuition basis to all individuals on a first-come, first-served basis. Limitations on age groups or prerequisites will be listed in advertising for the program. If enrollment in a particular class does not reach levels necessary to support a class, the class may be cancelled.
		With regard to transportation, the Board does not accept responsibility for any student.
3. Delega Respo	ation of nsibility	The Superintendent or his/her designee shall be responsible for developing regulations for the tuition-based summer school program.
		Guidelines for the operation of tuition-based summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of tuition-based summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions.
