125. DELAWARE VALLEY ADULT AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION
The Board recognizes the value of educational growth and advancement to adult members of the community and the need of both adults and minors for educational programs.
The Board may establish and maintain a program of adult education based upon the needs and interests of the residents, consistent with the educational goals and policies of the district.
The Board may employee staff, utilize available facilities, provide custodial services, supply instructional and supplementary materials and provide administrative leadership required to maintain the adult education program. The Board shall establish the tuition rate for each course offered in the adult education program.
Fees for adult courses will be published in the Adult Community Education flyer three (3) times a year. An additional out-of-district fee per course shall be applied to all nonresidents.
 The Superintendent or designee shall: Utilize appropriate staff members. Assess the needs and resources of the community. Develop a program of adult education and present that program to the Board for approval. Prepare a calendar of adult education activities. Develop and implement means to inform the public of adult education offerings. Nonresident Community Swim will be subject to additional charges.
