The reason they do not allow people to bring their own food is because they make an extremely small percentage off box office tickets. The bulk of revenue Flagship brings in comes from concessions sales. The concession sales pay for the movies, the recliners, theater décor, the sound system, the concession equipment, just to name a few. Popcorn is the top selling item at the snack stand.

As manager, she gets to watch all the movies for free as does her staff. The employees do not get discounts; however, they do get free popcorn, drinks and free movies, a definite perk for working there!

Surprisingly, the movie advertisement posters and props are not returned. The employees can take them after the cinema is done using them while the movie is in the theater. Sometimes, Flagship donates the posters as well.

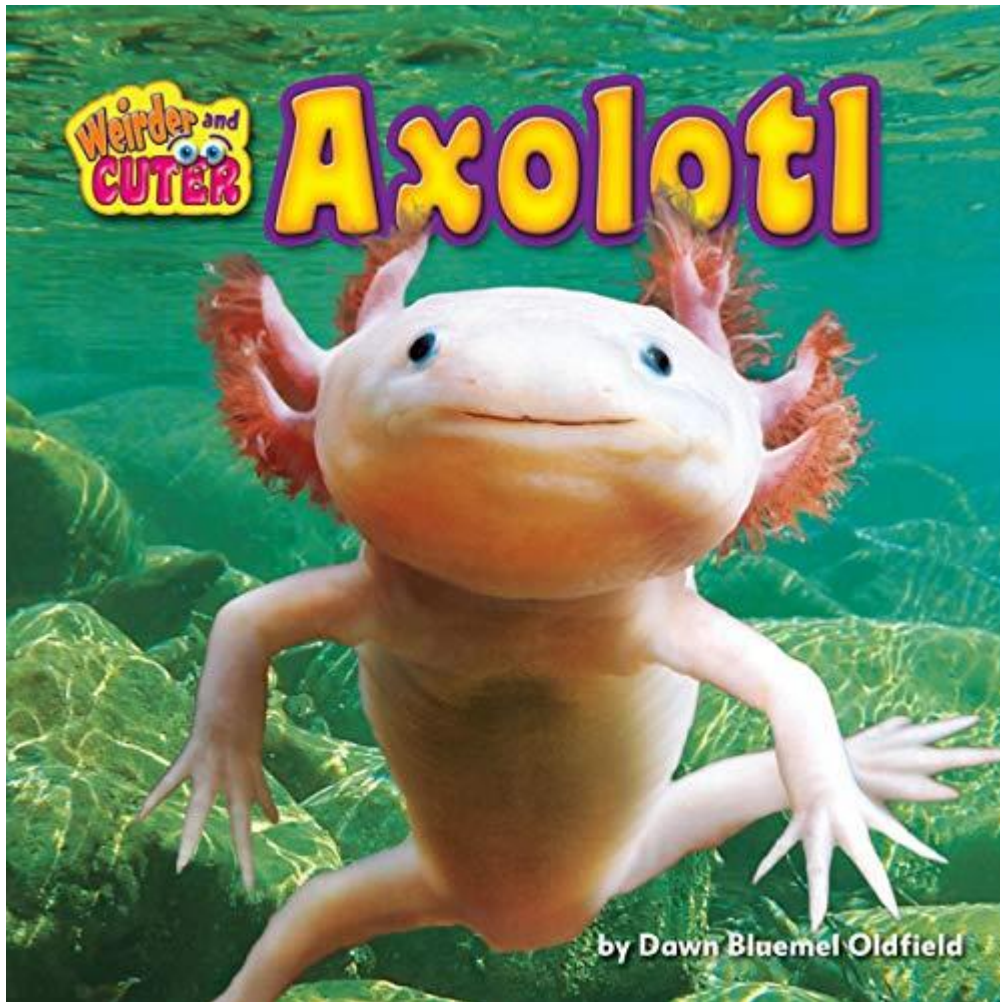

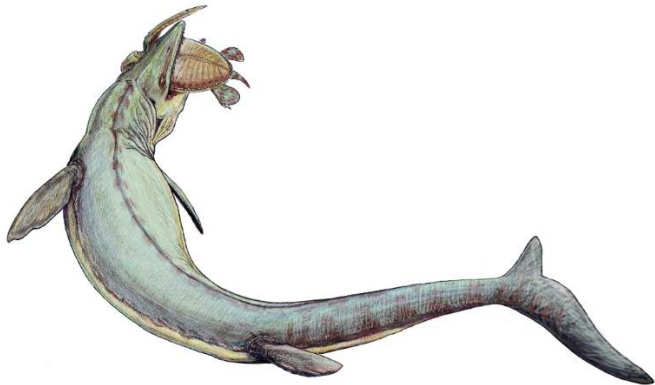

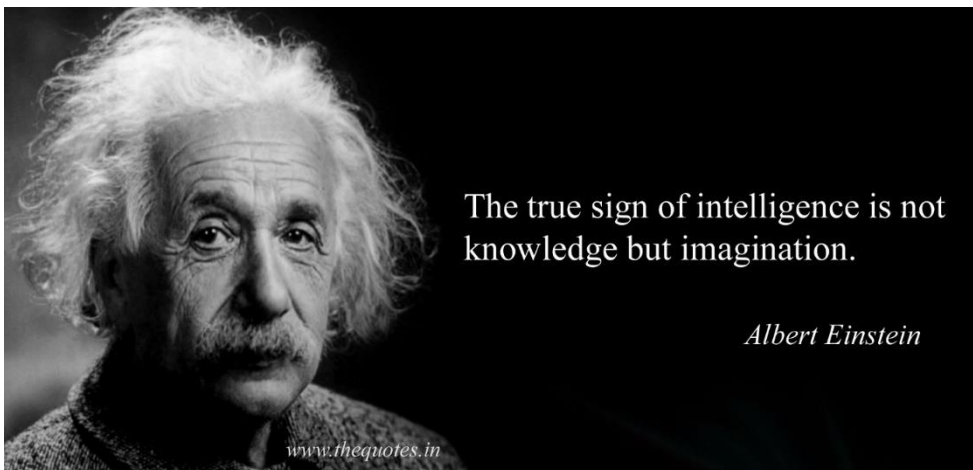
INTELLIGENCE

Przewalski's horse is back? I am happy to say YES! The foal is

the first Przewalski's horse born at the San Diego Zoo Safari Park since 2014 and is one of only four individuals born in North America over the past year. The baby horse was born as part of a program that ensures genetic diversity among Przewalski's horse populations, which is overseen by conservationists nationwide. Mostly, extinct in the wild, the Przewalski's horse has survived for the past 40 years almost entirely in zoos around the world, yay!
