

Patrick agrees with Ally because I feel like I am playing in the dark after school.


Veterans Day by Ally

A lion's roar can be heard up to eight kilometers away


Marshmallow Planet by Patrick




Pens & Pages in December

If you want, put some carrots and celery out in your front yard, that would be a yummy treat. too.



Brown pandas are very rare to be found, other than ordinary giant pandas, since pandas are already endangered.
Brown pandas have a smaller

skull and dark brown and light brown rather than black and white fur, and its smaller size, its eye spots are under the lower lid instead of around the eyes.

There are estimated to be only between 200 and 300 brown pandas left in the wild, they are found only in mountains of China, at altitudes of 4,00 to 10,000 feet (1,300 to 3,300 meters)
