
PREPARING YOUR CHILD FOR KINDERGARTEN

EVERYDAY COMMUNICATION YOUR CHILD SHOULD BE ABLE TO DO INDEPENDENTLY:

- Say their first and last name
- Say their teacher's name
- Say their **bus number** and **recognize their bus number** (You should practice this once you receive it.)



PERSONAL HYGIENE TO REDUCE THE SPREAD OF ILLNESSES

- Wear a mask over their nose and mouth
- Wash and dry hands
- Use the bathroom independently including zipping and buttoning pants
- Use a tissue to wipe and blow their nose
- Cough/sneeze into their elbow

FINE MOTOR SKILLS YOUR CHILD SHOULD BE ABLE TO ACCOMPLISH INDEPENDENTLY

- Put on and zip up a coat independently
- Pack up and put on a backpack independently
- Zip/unzip a backpack
- Open food containers at snack and lunch
- Hold a book and turn pages
- Correct pencil grip
- Cut with scissors



FINE MOTOR SKILLS YOUR CHILD SHOULD BE ABLE TO ACCOMPLISH INDEPENDENTLY

- Correct pencil grip
 - Pinch and Flip
 - Cotton ball trick




(Place a cotton ball in the palm of the hand, squeeze and hold pencil while doing so.)

- Cutting with scissors
 - Eyes and hands work together
 - Both sides of the body doing something at the same time
 - Develops concentration and attention to details
 - Use practice pages from website

PRACTICE HELPFUL BEHAVIORS

- Speaking to adults in school
- Taking turns and sharing with others
- Sit, listen and wait



- Follow one and two step instructions
- Raising hands and waiting until a teacher can help
- Keeping hands and feet to yourself

ACADEMIC PREPARATION DURING THE SUMMER

- Recognize first name
- Write first name (using uppercase letter for the first letter only)
- Say the alphabet (not singing it, ex. Imnop)
- Identify colors in an 8 count crayon pack
- Count 10 objects, pointing to each while counting
- Recognize basic shapes: square, circle, triangle, rectangle
- Recognize and name numbers to 10, (in and out of order)
- Recognize letters in the alphabet, uppercase and lowercase (In and out of order)
- Identify some letter sounds: Video shows correct letter sounds taught. Click the link:
