## Math Tip Worksheet

Knowing how to calculate a tip at a restaurant quickly and precisely is a good skill to have. It is acceptable to tip between 15 and 20 percent of your total bill. Use these examples to sharpen your tipping skills! Imagine you are in the restaurant. You will estimate a 20% tip and NOT use a calculator.

1. At Pizza Hut, your bill was \$15.97 plus tax. How much should you tip?

2. Your lunch bill came to \$9.87 plus tax. How much should you tip?

3. You and a friend ordered fajitas for two, and agreed to split the bill. The bill came to \$19.06. How much is your share of the tip?

4. You went to a coffeehouse with friends and ordered an iced coffee and desert, which came to \$6.87. How much of a tip should you leave?

5. At dinner, your waiter got your orders mixed up and then failed to refill your drink. The bill came to \$21.99. How much of a tip should you leave?
