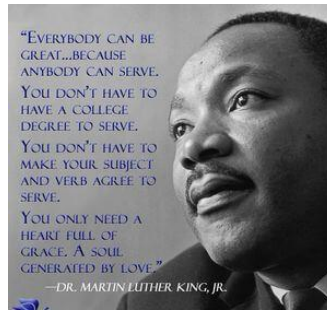


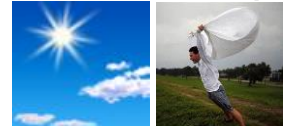

## TODAY IN HISTORY

In 1915, Aspirin was made available for the first time in [tablet](#) form. The pills were manufactured by Bayer pharmaceuticals in Germany. The [medicine](#) had previously been sold in powder form from [1 May 1899](#). Salicin, the parent compound of the salicylate drug family had been isolated from willow bark in 1829. From 1875, sodium salicylate was used as a commercial pain reliever, despite side effects such as bleeding of the stomach lining. On [10 Aug 1897](#), a German chemist, [Felix Hoffmann](#), working at the Bayer company, found a suitable, less acidic medication, acetylsalicylic acid. It was marketed by Bayer under the "Aspirin" trademark.
