

TODAY IN HISTORY

Died 18 Feb 1564 at age 88 (born [6 Mar](#) 1475).

Michelangelo Buonarroti was an Italian [artist](#) and architect known primarily for his works of art, but he also prepared extremely accurate anatomical drawings of the human body.
