TODAY IN HISTORY

In 1968, Sheri Schroeder was born the third child to Karen Schroeder, who lived beside the **Love**Canal chemical dump in the city of Niagara Falls, New York. It was the physical <u>problems</u> of her daughter at birth that prompted her mother to learn about the extent of the **Love Canal**environmental problem. A vigorous campaign brought it to the public's attention. Sheri was **born with**a heart that beat irregularly and had a hole in it, bone blockages of the nose, partial deafness, deformed ear

exteriors, and a cleft palate. From about the late 1930s, the <u>Hooker Company</u>, manufacturer of pesticides, plasticizers, and caustic soda, used the abandoned canal to dump over 20,000 tons of toxic waste residues which leaked into local homes.
