

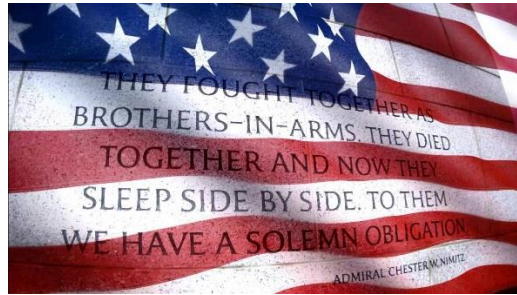

# THIS DAY IN HISTORY

## Memorial Day Facts

Formerly known as Decoration Day, it was first enacted to honor Union and Confederate soldiers following the American Civil War.

In May 1966, Waterloo, NY was officially declared the birthplace of Memorial Day by President Lyndon Johnson because the practice of decorating soldiers' graves was first observed on May 5, 1866 and each year thereafter.

On May 5, 1868, in his capacity as commander-in-chief of the Grand Army of the Republic, General John A. Logan issued a proclamation that "Decoration Day" should be observed nationwide. It was observed for the first time on May 30 of the same year.

Ironton, OH lays claim to the nation's oldest continuously running Memorial Day parade, a tradition since 1869. The first parade was held May 5, 1868.

The ceremonies and Memorial Day address at Gettysburg National Park were nationally famous, starting in 1868.
