


Welcome to the D.D.P.S Art Show!



















Each grade level learns about what a *landscape* is and what is needed to create one. We study landscape paintings and turn our attention to looking outside our window!


















First grade studied the landscapes of Claude Monet, primarily focusing on his water lily paintings.









Kindergarten focused their attention on Georges Seurat, a pointillism artist and created their own pointillism beach paintings!











First grade studied painting created by Wayne Thiebaud, which they all loved! They all thought his paintings were very realistic and made them hungry!

















We often read many stories in the art room and create art that goes along with different components of the stories.










