How-To Make a Duct Tape Bow-Pen

Step 1: Get a 7" strip of tape and fold it in half to make a 31/2" double-sided strip.

Step 2: Get a 1/2" x 2" strip of tape.

Step 3: Pinch the 31/2" strip to make a bow.



Step 4: Take the other strip and wrap it around it to keep the bow in shape.



Step 5: Fold the bow outward to make it puff.

Step 6: Decorate the pen with both colors of tape.



Step 7: Use another strip to attach the bow to the pen.

DVMS Students get "Spooky" at Halloween Dance By: Jillian Corwin






