

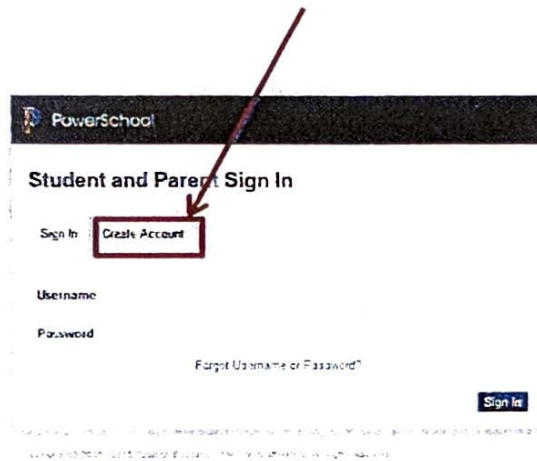
Creating a Single Sign-On PowerSchool Parent Portal Account

(To be used by parents who are new to DVSD, or by parents who did not create an ID and PW last year.)

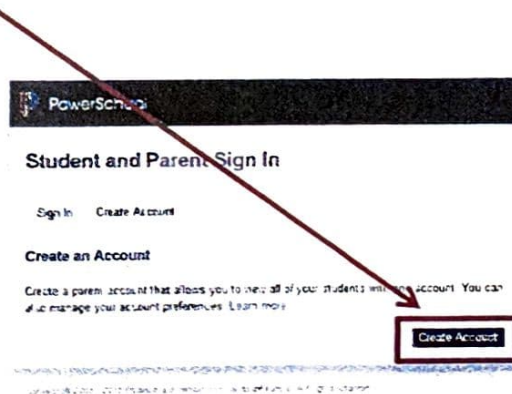


Parent Single Sign-On enables parents/guardians to access their students' academic records using the PowerSchool Parent Portal. This Quick Reference Guide is designed to assist you through the process of enabling and setting up Parent Single Sign-On in PowerSchool.

1. In your browser, go to <https://powerschool.dvsdedu.org/public>.
2. When you see this screen, click on the tab Create Account.



3. Click on Create Account.



6. When finished entering your student(s), click on Enter.
